But when considering this path, you may be concerned about how to handle the printing and cutting. Home inkjet or laser printers don't work well with the special papers you may want to use for invitations, and cutting hundreds of sheets with scissors or a rotary cutter is time-consuming and error-prone. Many printers don't want to be bothered with small, custom jobs of this sort or may not want to print on special papers.

What's the best way to work with us?

Think first about the design. There are web sites, books, and other resources to help you come up with the design for your invitation - whether you're thinking of a simple invitation and RSVP card, or a multi-page packet. Go ahead and design your cards using a program you're familiar with, including Word or Publisher.

Next visit a specialty paper store, like Paper Depot or Anchor Paper, to select and purchase the type, weight, and color(s) of paper that you want. We at PostNet have worked with all sorts of papers, including Stardream and vellum.

Then it's time to visit PostNet. Bring your design files and paper, and talk with us about how you'd like us to help you.

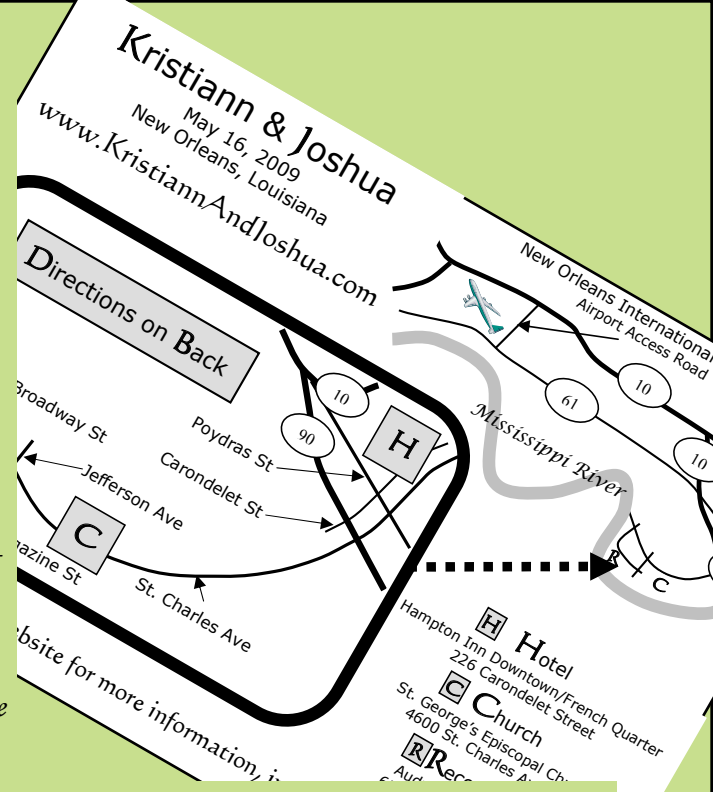

Services...

PostNet can help you with any or all of the following services. And if there's something you need help on that's not shown here, just ask!

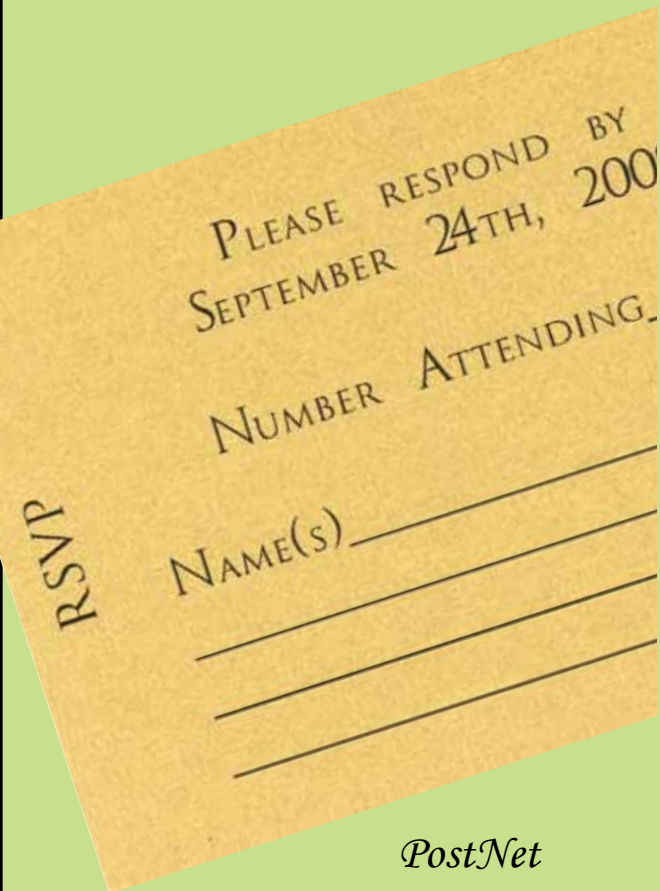
- printing - black or color ink, on a wide variety of standard and specialty papers and envelopes
- cutting - we can cut paper, either paper we've printed on, or blank paper that's part of your design
- scoring and folding - we can score heavy card stock to make folding easier and cleaner, and can also do the folding
- design and layout - we can help you design your invitations, and actually prefer to lay out multiple items per sheet for you
- names - an interesting option to consider for RSVP cards is to print each card with the name(s) of the invitees, rather than having a generic card with blank lines - we can help set this up and print the names as we print the cards



Hints and Suggestions...

We'd like to make the following suggestions to reduce your time and effort, and to give you the best results.

- when you design your card(s) don't worry about laying out multiple items on a sheet - we can do that more precisely and effectively
- make sure there's no text or art real close to the border of any of the cards
- we suggest not trying to print colors or subtle gray scale on metallic papers (like Stardream); the paper can absorb ink in unexpected ways
- when buying paper, make sure you buy about 10-20% extra, especially for heavy card stocks
- buy paper that's 8.5x11 inches; don't have it pre-cut to invitation size or buy prepackaged invitations - we might not be able to print on it
- you can bring your files in on a jump drive, CD, or DVD, or you can e-mail them to us. And don't forget to include any special or unusual fonts you've used
- bring in a printed copy of what each card should look like, along with details on the sizes of each card
